- Sustainability of project through the assistance of IAATE funding and beyond.

Successful applicants will be required to provide a written report for the IAATE website and *The Flyer* within the grant year. In addition, grantees may be asked to provide a short project report at the annual conference. However, attendance at the Annual Conference is not required.

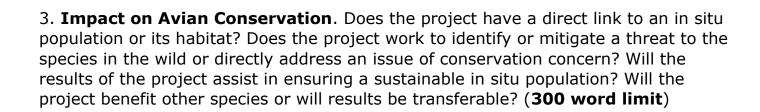

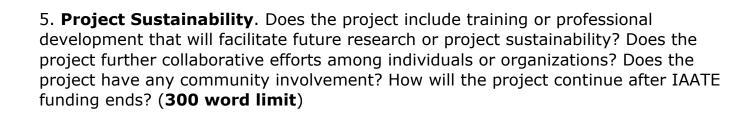
